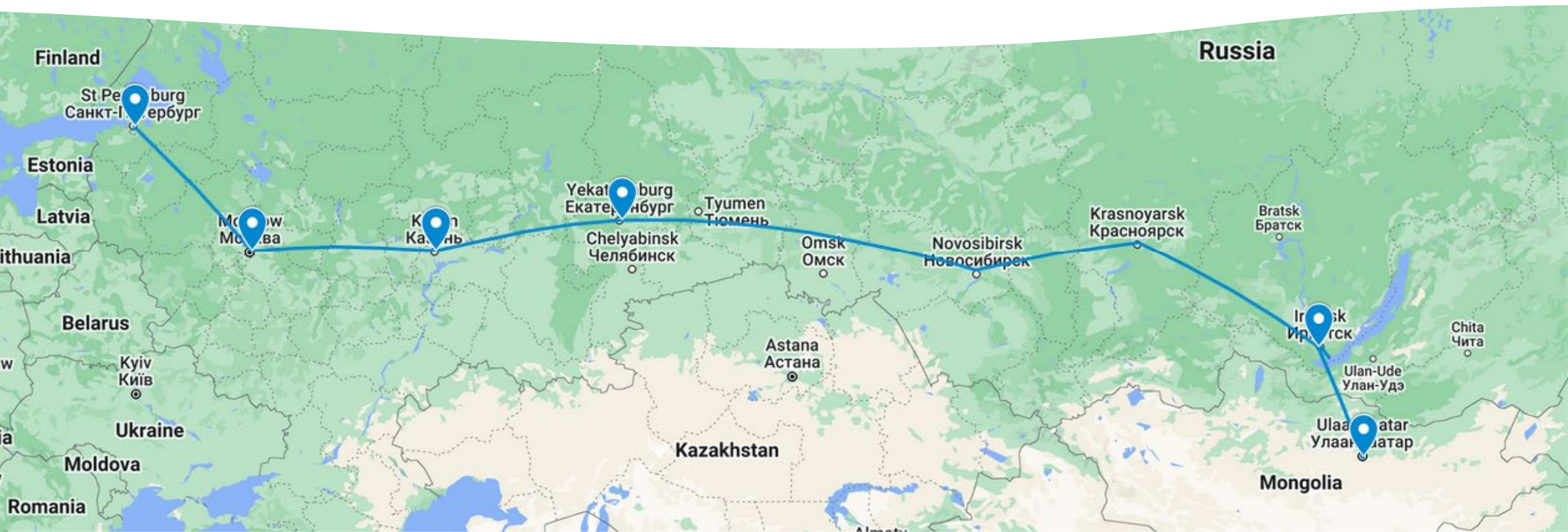

Basic information



Summer-Autumn transition. Pleasant weather with sunny days



Temperature : 8 – 25 degree Celsius (as low as 5 in Siberia with wind)



Day light : 05:20hrs – 19:40hrs (~14 hours day light)



Bring cash in USD or EUR for personal expenses. (you can change with us from MYR – RUB too)



Hotel breakfast included.



Power socket type C (European style). Train cabin also have 220V sockets



Evisa for Russia will be hand over by early August. Free visa to Mongolia

20 August 2026: Departure from KL

- Departure from KLIA at 10 am. Meet and briefing at KLIA at 6:00am. Check in starts at 6 am. (meet up is not compulsory.)
- If you decide to arrive at airport and check in later, we will meet again later in airport terminal or in Dubai airport.
- While transit in Dubai, please make sure to check the terminal and departure gate for connection flight to St Petersburg.
- Arrival in St Petersburg at 9.20pm. Check in hotel and rest.

Notes:

- Upon arrival in airport, bus will wait at the parking site outside the terminal. We have to walk to the bus around 150 meters from the arrival gate.
- Expect to check in to your hotel by 11pm. Hotel Best Western Plus (3N)
- Our hotel for these next 3 nights is close to mall, convenience stores, restaurants/cafes, money changer, network service providers, and train station.

21 August 2026 : St Petersburg



- Breakfast start at 6.30 am
- Saint Petersburg city tour starts at 9 am.
 - Nevsky Prospect (Church of savior on spilled blood entrance included)
 - Hermitage and Winter Palace (entrance fee included)
- City tour end at 5 pm. Free and easy in the evening
- In the evening, stroll along nevsky prospect. There are many restaurants, cafes, souvenir shops and many interesting places to explore . Our hotel is just at the end of nevsky prospect.

Notes:

- Opposite our hotel, there is a Galleria Mall, on the top floor, there is a food hub with many option for food, including halal food, Chinese cuisine, Japanese cuisine, Turkish, and Mexico cuisines.

22 August 2026: Peterhof lower garden

- Visit Peterhof Lower Garden, also known as the Russian Versailles
- Journey takes 1 hour from our hotel.
- You can explore the place at your own pace. Very big estate with beautiful water fountains and cascade.
- Flowers are fully in bloom during this time.
- Back to hotel by 3pm.
- Meals : B/L/-

Notes:

- Bring enough water and some snack if needed.
- Optional activity: Midnight cruise to watch the draw bridge being lifted up for ship passage from 12:00am – 2:00 am (RM360/pax including transfers to and from hotel)



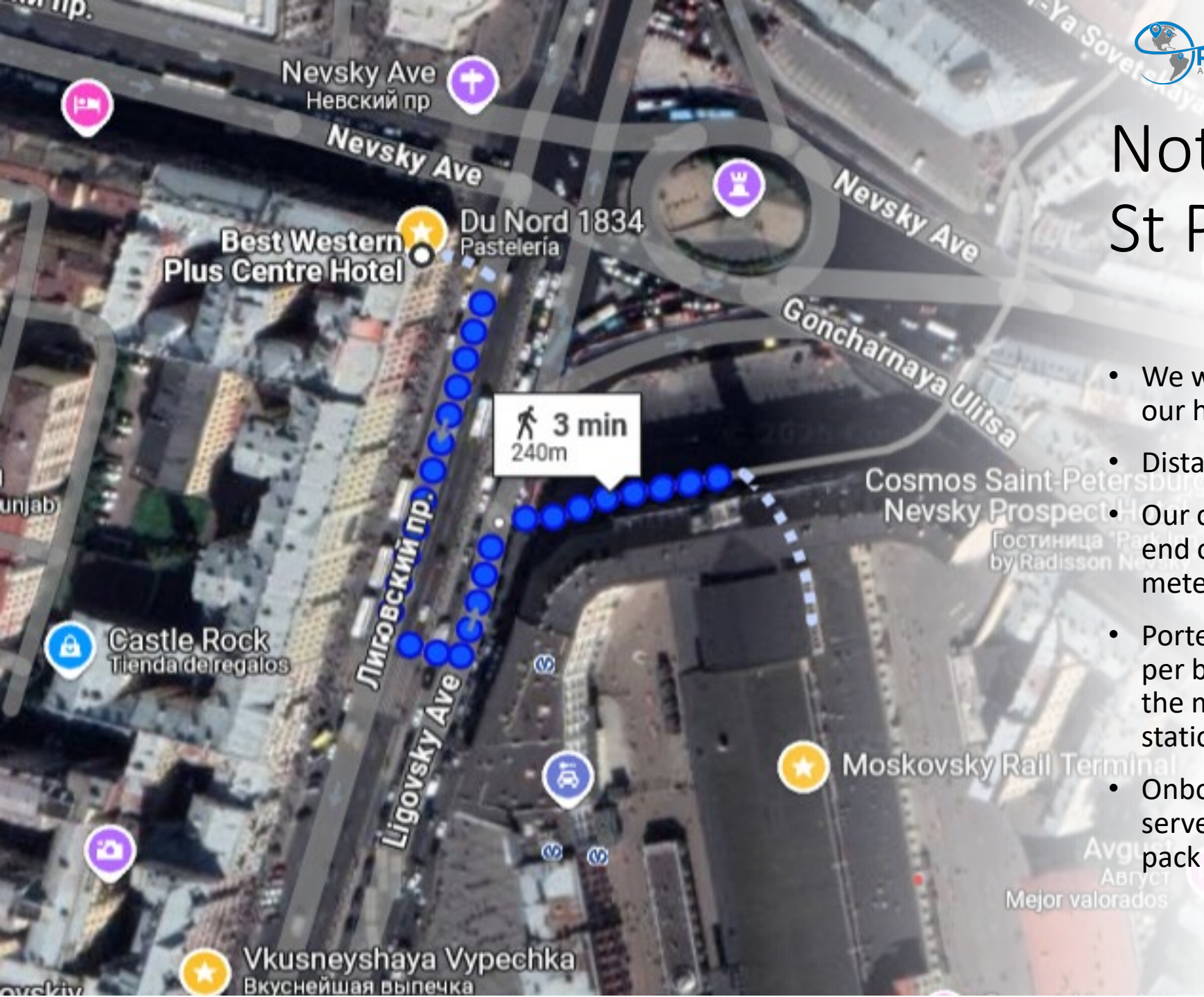
23 August 2026 : Moscow

- After breakfast, check out from hotel at 8 am, and take all luggage to train station.
- Morning Sapsan fast train to Moscow (9:10am)
- Arrival in Moscow in the afternoon. (1:10pm)
- Upon arrival, transfer to Izmailovo flea market for souvenir shopping. Here, you can bargain.
- Check in hotel around 5pm.
- Night in Moscow
- Meals: B/L/-



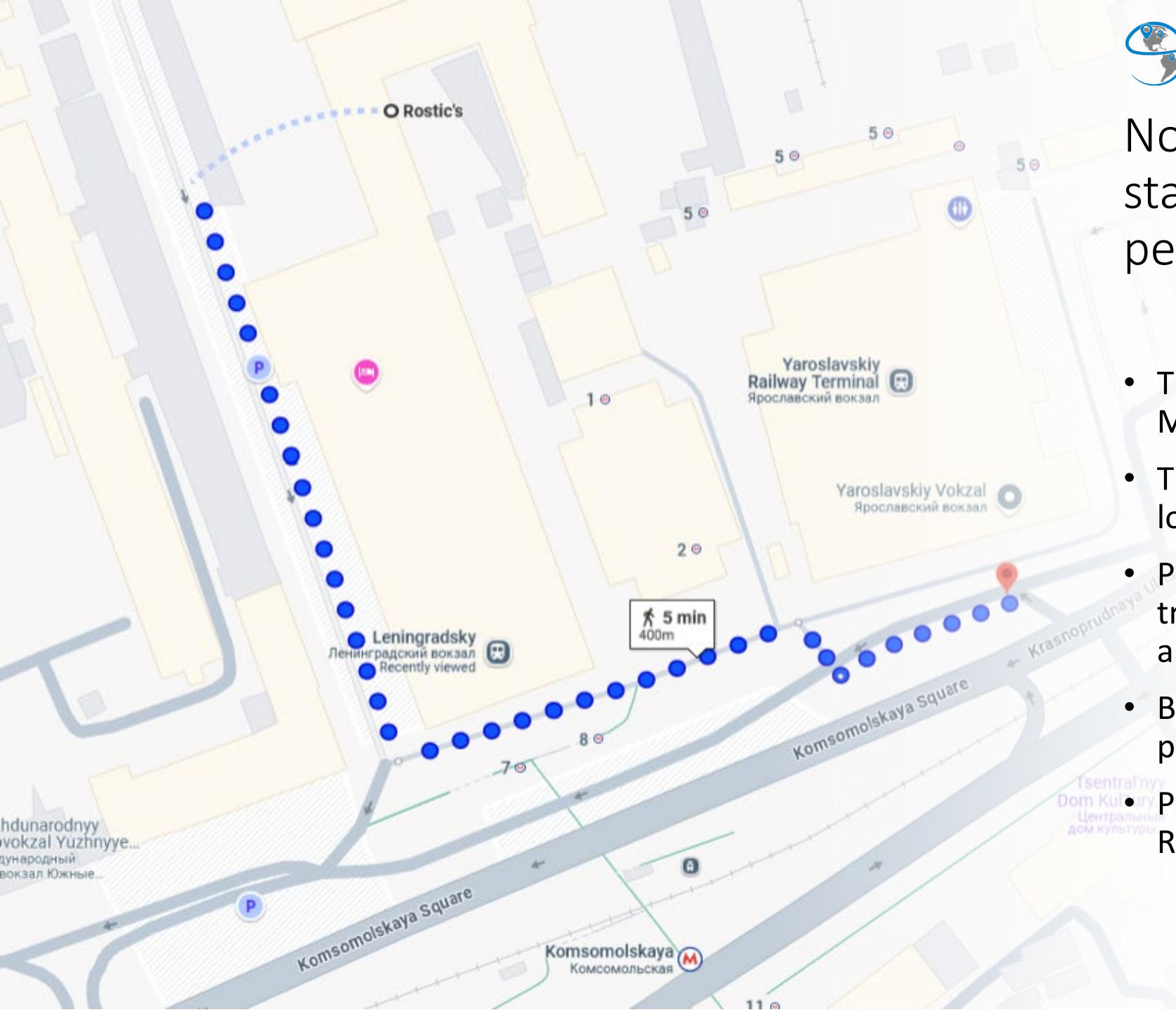
Notes: St Pete station

- We will walk to the train station from our hotel in Saint Petersburg.
- Distance to the station is 250m.
- Our carriage August be at the other end of the train. Expect around 100 meter additional to the carriage.
- Porter service is available for RUB 400 per bag. Porter service only start from the main entrance of the railway station to your carriage
- Onboard the train, light snack will be served. For muslim, recommended to pack your own snack.



Notes: Moscow train station (arrival from St pete)

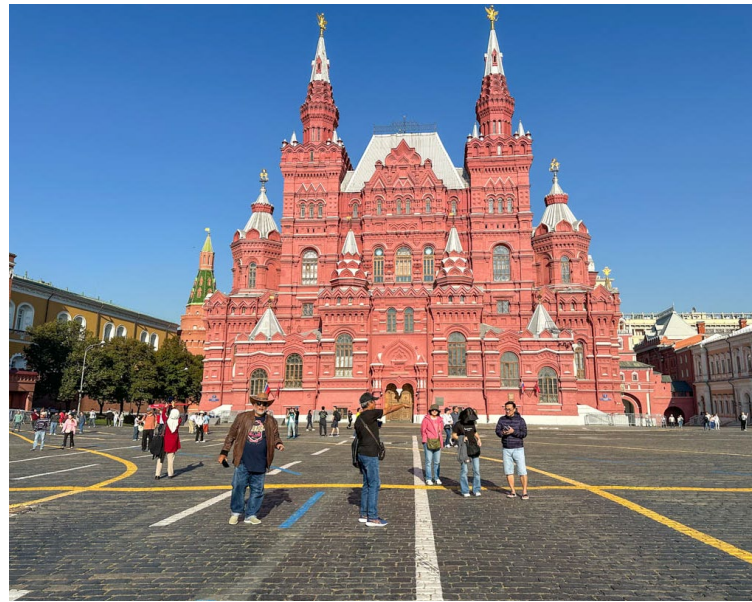
- The arrival train station terminal in Moscow is under renovation.
- The bus cannot park at the parking lot beside the train station.
- Passengers have to walk out of the train station to the main road approximately 400 meters away.
- Bus will pick us up at the pick up point.
- Porter service is available at RUB 400/bag



24 August 2026

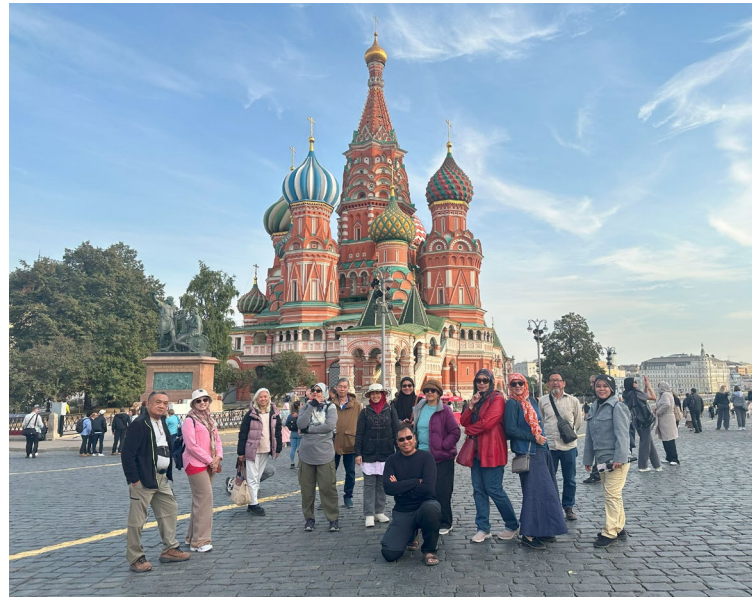
- Today, we will have our walking tour to the Red Square and explore Moscow metro networks
- In the evening, stroll along the Arbat street
- There will be a lot of walk, going up and down escalators, and changing metros and walking around the square.
- Meals: B/L/-





25 August 2026 : Moscow

- Check out at 12:00 pm.
- Our day begins with a comprehensive sightseeing tour around Moscow main sites such as Moscow state university building, sparrow hill lookout, and Moscow grand mosque
- Drop at Kazansky railway station at 7pm. Our train departs just at 8 pm.
- Meals: B/L/-



26 August 2026 : Kazan

- Arrival at 8 am in Kazan city
- Your journey from Moscow brings us to the vibrant city of Kazan, where you embark on a captivating city tour, centered around its iconic Kremlin.
- For lunch, venture to a local Tatar restaurant, offering an opportunity to savor the flavors of Tatar cuisine and immerse ourselves in the unique culinary heritage of the region.
- City tour ends by 14:00 hrs, check in to your day room and take a rest and refresh.
- Enjoy your free time at Baumann Street.
- Check out at 22:30 hrs and transfer to the train station.
- Night on board the train (Train departure at 00:30 hrs)
- Meals: breakfast provided in the train/L/-



Notes:

- Breakfast onboard the train is provided in the train arriving from Moscow
- No Shower compartment on board the train from Moscow.
- We will arrive at Kazan station . There is no porter available here. You will have to carry luggage up and down the lift, crossing the platforms to the main terminal. Our bus will be waiting in front of the main terminal.
- We will not stay overnight in Kazan city, but continue to our next train leg at midnight.
- No shower compartment available on board the train to Ekaterinburg.



27 August 2026: Yekaterinburg



- Today the train arrives in Yekaterinburg, capital of the Ural Mountains by 3.30pm.
- An excursion into the Ural forests takes you to Ganina Yama, which today is considered by Russians as a "holy place". It is an assemble of small wooden chapels which were erected in the 1990's to honor the last Czar's family of the Romanov dynasty who were then buried in Ganina Yama.
- Yekaterinburg is located at the geographical border defined by scientists between Europe and Asia where you can stand on the Asia-Europe obelisk.
- Night in Yekaterinburg.
- Hotel 4 elements (1N)
- Meals: -/-/-
- Breakfast and lunch on board the train on your own

28 August 2026

- Check out by 9:30 am,
- On your sightseeing tour you visit a place of remarkable importance for Russian history: the “Cathedral on The Blood” which was built at the place where Czar Nicholas II and his family were executed by the Bolsheviks in 1918.
- Transfer to train station at 11 am for the journey into Siberia.
- Your train passes through the Ural Mountains and an endless scenery of forests, lakes and small settlements.
- Night onboard the train
- Meals: B/-/-

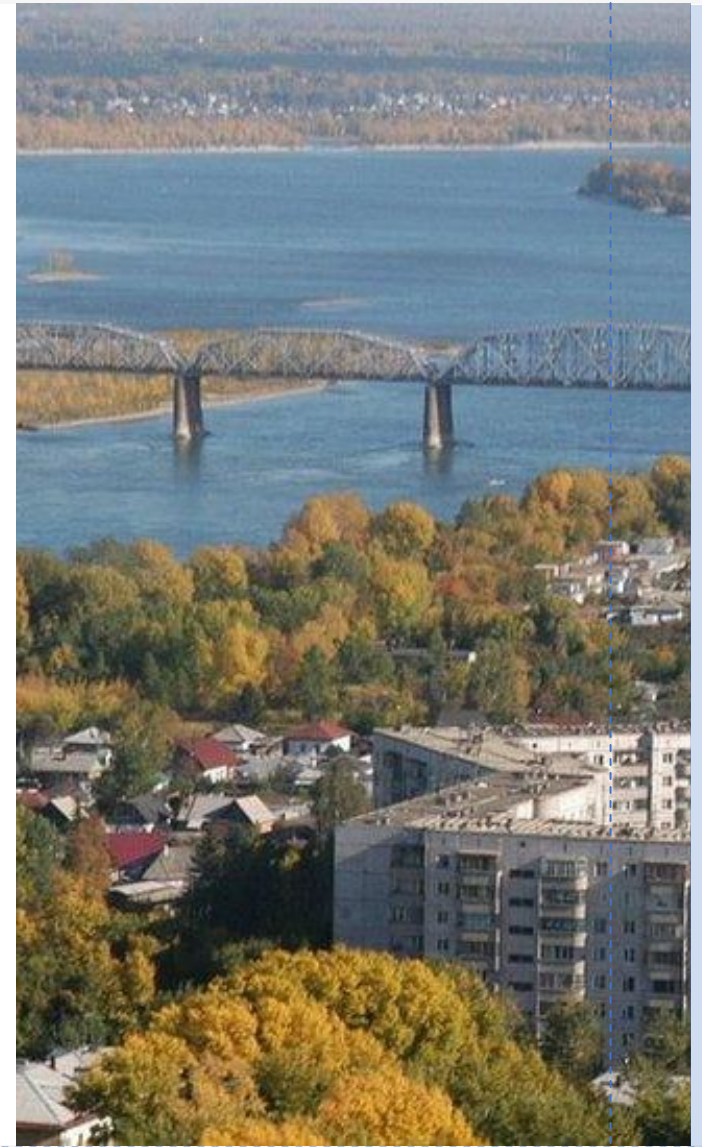
Notes:

- This train will be your home for the next 54 hours
- The power sockets in the cabin provides 220V power. You can use it for laptop, mini rice cooker etc
- There is free flow drinking water (hot and normal)
- If you need to use microwave, you can ask for the attendant assistance



29 August 2026: Onboard the train – passing Novosibirsk

- On board the train.
- The train will have an hour stop at Novosibirsk. (no city visit) (11:50am)
- You can go out from the station to stock up some snacks or food.
- Our journey continue passing the Siberian taiga
- Meals: -/-/-
- Restaurant wagon available. You can order food to eat there or to be sent to your cabin.
- Shower available onboard



30 August 2026: Onboard train – arrival in Irkutsk

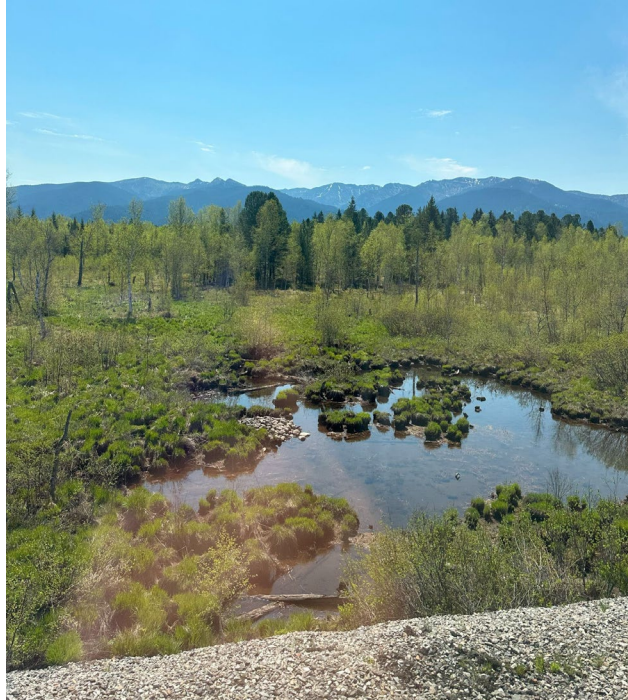
- On board the train for another day.
- Sit back and relax
- You have 50 mins stop at Krasnoyarsk after midnight.
- Arrival in Irkutsk at 9pm
- Transfer to hotel
- Meals: -/-/-



31 August 2026 : Lake Baikal

- Prepare to be amazed by one of the tour's most remarkable highlights as we journey to Lake Baikal.
- Lake Baikal, with its vast freshwater reserves, captivates with its pristine beauty. Delve into the depths of this natural wonder, as it reaches an astounding 1,620 meters at its deepest point.
- Surrounded by majestic mountain ranges and showcasing its deep blue waters, Lake Baikal promises an unforgettable experience that will stay with you forever.
- Optional activity: lake Baikal cruise: RUB 1200/pax (to be paid in Irkutsk. Weather dependant)
- Meals: B/L/-
- Hotel Irkutsk city center (2N)





1 Sept 2026 : Departure to Ulaanbaatar

- Train departure to Ulaanbaatar at 08:05hrs
- The train will circumnavigate long the lake Baikal shore line for ~3 hours before making a turn to Ulan Ude.
- We will arrive at the Russian border at around 19:57hrs.
- The process at each border take approximately 1h 40m.
- Just stay in your cabin. Immigration and custom officers will come and handle the border crossing process.
- Then train will move into Mongolian side, and arrive at Mongolian border after 40 minutes
- Same thing in Mongolian side (Sukhbaatar). Stay in the cabin, they will come and do the checking. Another 1h 50mins)
- You will get an arrival card for the Mongolian custom in advance.
- Toilets will be locked during these border crossings
- Immigration and custom officers will board the train, collect passport and luggage inspection.
- Meals: B/-/- (all meals on your own onboard the train. No restaurant wagon in this train)



2 Sept 2026 : Terelj National Park

- Arrival in Ulaanbaatar at 06:38 hrs
- Transfer to Terelj National Park. Explore the national park and visit Turtle Rock formation
- Continue to visit the Ariyabal meditation temple – surrounded by scenic mountains with massive rock formations and sits on top of the mountain.
- Visit nomad family and try dairy product.
- Here you will have the opportunity to ride horse or try archery.
- Night in Ger Camp.
- Meals: B/L/D

Notes:

- There will be a 40 minutes hike to Ariyabal temple. Those who choose not to hike up, can wait at the café near the entrance



Notes:

- Ger camp is a modern tourist ger, centrally heated for your comfort.
- The standard ger is not equipped with attached bathroom for guests to experience nomadic style close to the traditional ger like the nomad.
- However, there is an option to upgrade your ger to an attached bathroom Ger for RM 550/ger





3 September 2026:
Ulaanbaatar

- After breakfast, check out and drive back to Ulaanbaatar city for half day city tour
- On the way back, visit Chinggis Khan equestrian complex and museum.
- In the city, visit Sukhbaatar square and national museum.
- Grandhill hotel Ulaanbaatar (1N)
- Meals: B/L/-



4 Sept 2026 : End of tour

- Transfer to Airport at 7:30 am
- Flight departure from Ulaanbaatar at 11:50 am
- 2.5 hours layover at Peking airport.
- Arrival in Kuala Lumpur at 11pm

Aout the train



About the Train:

- 4 berth cabin accommodate 4 pax per cabin while 2 berth cabin accommodates 2 pax per cabin
- 2 Toilets for each carriage, shared among the passengers in 8 cabins
- No attached toilet in the cabin.
- We will not use the same train for the whole journey.
- Some trains do have designated first class cabin (2 berths), and some don't. Trains without first class cabin, we will put you in the second class cabin but only for 2 pax (for 1st class passengers). Upper beds can be folded to the cabin wall for more space.
- There is no restaurant wagon on the train between Irkutsk and Ulan bator.
- Free flow drinking boiled water in the train, and there is also a microwave in the attendant room. You can ask the attendant to use microwave to heat your food.
- There are 2 – 4 power sockets with 220V output in each cabin
- Train cabin usually set at room temperature (Air conditioned)

5 train routes:

1. Saint Petersburg – Moscow:

- Fast train (4 hours)
- Seating

2. Moscow – Kazan :

- Overnight train (13 hours)
- No shower compartment

3. Kazan – Ekaterinburg :

- Overnight train (14 hours)
- Shower compartment available
- Restaurant wagon available

4. Ekaterinburg – Irkutsk :

- Longest train ride (54 hours)
- Shower compartment available
- Restaurant wagon available

5. Irkutsk – Ulaanbaatar :

- 1 day train (23 hours)
- Shower not available
- Restaurant wagon depends on train

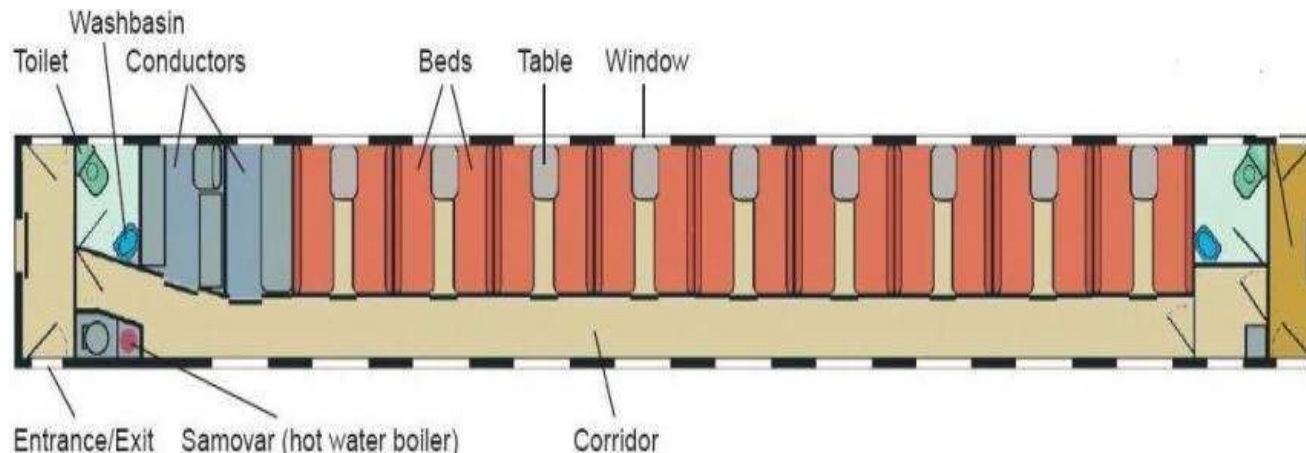
4 berths cabin

- Standard cabins are equipped with 2 lower beds and 2 upper beds.
- Cabins and carriage are well air conditioned/heated to room temperature.
- 4 Sockets for 220 V are available in each cabin, capable for razors, loading mobile phones, cameras and notebooks.
- Each cabins can accommodate up to 4 pax if you were to utilise all 4 beds.
- 2 toilets are available in each carriage



2 berth cabin

- 2 berth cabin are the same feature with the 4 berths cabin. While only the two lower beds are used for sleeping, the two upper beds can be used as additional storage for luggage – or they can be folded away.
- Cabins and carriage are well air conditioned/heated to room temperature.
- 2 Toilets and washbasins for common use are situated either at each end of the carriage.
- 4 Sockets for 220 V are available in each cabin, capable for razors, loading mobile phones, cameras and notebooks.



Daily shower facilities are guaranteed.

- Shower facilities are available in Saint Petersburg, Moscow, Ekaterinburg, Irkutsk, and Ulaanbaatar in your hotel rooms where you stay overnight. In addition to that hotel day rooms for showers are at your disposal during stops in and Kazan (one day room per roommate).
- Therefore, you have guaranteed access to showers in your hotel room every day during the entire journey

EVERYTHING YOU NEED TO KNOW:

- Due to western sanction on Russia, Visa, Mastercard and union pay cards issued outside of Russia no longer accepted in Russia. Participants will need to bring enough cash in USD or EUR to be converted in Russia.
- You will stay in a 4 stars hotel in cities and 1 night in a Ger camp in Mongolia for nomadic lifestyle experience. **Standard Ger camp is with shared bathroom facilities. Upgrade to an attached bathroom is available for RM550/ger**
- All transportations during the trip are private transport.
- Please allocate RM40-50 for each meal that is not included (This is in higher price range.)
- Please printout a copy of your Evisa (to be issued soon). Evisa is required during flight check in from Kuala Lumpur to St Petersburg.
- Temperature ranges between 8 – 25 degree celcius (8 degrees at night in Siberia region and mongolia)
- You might want to bring a light jacket/wind breaker. In Siberia and Mongolia, there can be windy and lower temperature at night.
